The main focus of the program was to expose the current students of the Institute towards getting practical knowledge and guidance in their professional journey. Mr. Monesh Rathod, who is one of the distinguished Alumnus of M. Tech. Biotechnology (2004-2009) and currently an entrepreneur, was invited as the guest speaker.

The session began with the introduction of the guest speaker by Dr. Ashwini Puntambekar, Member, Alumni and Placement Committee, DYPBBI. Dr. Neelu Nawani, Director, DYPBBI, gave her valuable insights about the Aptitude building Program and encouraged the students to participate in these activities. This program establishes a scientific connect and also enhances the overall development of students as multi-faceted professionals. She also asked the students to interact and collaborate with the Alumni. Mr. Monesh began the talk by sharing some of his student life experiences with the present students.

He asked the students about the different courses they learn in their curriculum and elaborated on the market needs of some of the subjects like: Fermentation technology in manufacturing of dyes, Animal tissue culture in



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

He also explained the role of Bioinformatics in research, roles of subjects like enzymology and microbiology and environmental sciences in career building.
